

FLAT SEAM (GARTER STITCH FABRIC)

A flat seam may be worked from either the right or the wrong side of the work.

When stitching 2 pieces of garter stitch fabric together we suggest working as follows –

When joining the triangle sides, place the 2 pieces of fabric evenly together and stitch one row at a time, always bringing the needle up from underneath through the centre of the stitch, then in the same manner through corresponding stitch on second piece (A).

When joining cast-on edges, sew through the edge of each cast-on stitch, always bringing the needle up from underneath through the centre of the stitch, then in the same manner through the corresponding stitch in the second piece (B).

Note – Always keep the seam elastic – there should be as much stretch in your seam as there is in the rest of your item.
