

RABBIT



Intermediate Crochet

Measurements

Height (approx, excluding ears) cm 10

Materials

PANDA MAGNUM SOFT 8 ply 100g balls

Colourway 1

Main Colour (**M** – 4600 White) 1
1st Contrast (**C1** – 4601 Butter) 1
2nd Contrast (**C2** – 6768 Pink) 1
Small quantity Black (4614) for eyes.

Colourway 2

Main Colour (**M** – 4601 Butter) 1
1st Contrast (**C1** – 4600 White) 1
2nd Contrast (**C2** – 2541 Sky) 1
Small quantity Black (4614) for eyes.

Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results. Quantities are approximate as they can vary between crochet workers.

- 3.50mm (UK 9) crochet hook.
- wool needle for finishing.
- polyester fibre filling.
- bell (optional).

Tension

Correct tension is not essential for this toy.

Note – Toy is worked on a smaller hook and at a firmer tension than usually recommended for this yarn.

Special Abbreviation

Dec = draw up a lp in each of next 2 sts, yoh and draw through all 3 lps on hook.

Note – We recommend parental supervision for children under 3 years as this toy has small parts which may present a choking hazard.

Body (beg at nose)

Using 3.50mm hook and **C1**, make 2ch.

1st round – Miss 1ch, 6dc in 2nd ch from hook, **do not turn**.

Note – As rounds are not completed with a sl st but worked in a spiral shape, mark end of rounds with a contrasting thread or safety pin.

2nd round – (**Do not** beg with a ch), (2dc in next dc) 6 times, do not join ... 12dc.

3rd round – (2dc in next dc, 1dc in next dc) 6 times ... 18dc.

Note – When changing colour, use new colour to work final lp of last st in old colour.

Change to **M** for rem.

4th round – (2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 2dc) 6 times ... 24dc.



5th round – (2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 3dc) 6 times ... 30dc.

6th round – (2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 4dc) 6 times ... 36dc.

Work 1 round.

8th round – (2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 5dc) 6 times ... 42dc.

Work 1 round.

10th round – (2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 6dc) 6 times ... 48dc.

Work 2 rounds.

13th round – (2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 7dc) 6 times ... 54dc.

Work 4 rounds.

18th round – (**Dec**, 1dc in each of next 7dc) 6 times ... 48 sts.

Work 2 rounds.

21st round – (**Dec**, 1dc in each of next 6dc) 6 times ... 42 sts.

Work 1 round.

23rd round – (**Dec**, 1dc in each of next 5dc) 6 times ... 36 sts.

Work 1 round.

25th round – (**Dec**, 1dc in each of next 4dc) 6 times ... 30 sts.

26th round – (**Dec**, 1dc in each of next 3dc) 6 times ... 24 sts.

Stuff body with polyester fibre filling, placing bell in centre (if desired).

27th round – (**Dec**, 1dc in each of next 2dc) 6 times ... 18 sts.

28th round – (**Dec**, 1dc in next dc) 6 times ... 12 sts.

29th round – (**Dec**) 6 times ... 6 sts.

Fasten off.

Note – Add extra stuffing before final closure, if necessary. Thread end through rem sts, draw up tightly and stitch to secure.

Arms (make 2)

Using 3.50mm hook and **C1**, make 2ch.
Work rounds 1 and 2 as for Body ... 12dc.
Change to **M**.
3rd round – 1dc in each of next 12dc.
Rep last round 4 times.
Fasten off.

Legs (make 2)

Using 3.50mm hook and **C1**, make 2ch.
Work rounds 1 to 3 incl as for Body ... 18dc.
Change to **M**.
4th round – 1dc in each of next 18dc.
5th round – 2dc in each of first 4dc, 1dc in each of next 14dc ... 22dc.
6th round – 1dc in each of first 3dc, 2dc in each of next 2dc, 1dc in each of next 17dc ... 24dc.
7th round – (**Dec**) 5 times, 1dc in each of next 14dc ... 19 sts.
8th round – **Dec**, 1dc in next st, **Dec**, 1dc in each of next 14 sts ... 17 sts.
9th round – 1dc in each of next 6 sts, 1htr in each of next 8 sts, 1dc in each of next 3 sts.
Rep last round once.
Fasten off.

Tail

Using 3.50mm hook and **M**, make 2ch.
Work rounds 1 and 2 as for Body ... 12dc.
3rd round – 1dc in each of next 12dc.
4th round – (2dc in next dc, 1dc in next dc) 6 times ... 18dc.
Work 2 rounds.
7th round – (**Dec**, 1dc in next st) 6 times ... 12 sts.
Stuff tail with polyester fibre filling.
8th round – (**Dec**) 6 times ... 6 sts.
Fasten off.
Thread end through rem sts, draw up tightly and stitch to secure.

Inner Ears (make 2)

Using 3.50mm hook and **C2**, make 4ch.
1st row – Miss 1ch, 1dc in each ch to end ... 3dc.
2nd row – 1ch, 1dc in each dc to end.
Work 1 row.
4th row – 1ch, 1dc in first dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in last dc ... 4dc.
Work 3 rows.

8th row – 1ch, 1dc in first dc, 2dc in each of next 2dc, 1dc in last dc ... 6dc.
Work 5 rows.
14th row – 1ch, 1dc in first dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 2dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in last dc ... 8dc.
Work 7 rows.
22nd row – Sl st in each of first 2dc, 1dc in each of next 4dc, sl st in each of last 2dc.
Fasten off.

Outer Ears (make 2)

Using 3.50mm hook and **M**, make 8ch and join with a sl st in first ch, taking care not to twist ch.
1st round – 1ch, 1dc in same st as sl st, 1dc in each ch to end, (work in spiral, do not join with sl st) ... 8dc.
Work 1 round.
3rd round – 2dc in first dc, 1dc in each of next 7dc ... 9dc.
Work 1 round.
5th round – 2dc in first dc, 1dc in each of next 8dc ... 10dc.
Work 1 round, **turn**.
Rem of Outer Ears is worked in rows, not rounds.
1st row – 1ch, 1dc in each of next 8dc, **turn**.
Rep last row once.
3rd row – 1ch, 1dc in first dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 4dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in last dc ... 10dc.
Work 5 rows.
9th row – 1ch, 1dc in first dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 6dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in last dc ... 12dc.
Work 5 rows.
15th row – 1ch, 1dc in first dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 8dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in last dc ... 14dc.
Work 2 rows.
18th row – 1ch, 1dc in first dc, (**Dec**, 1dc in each of next 3dc) twice, **Dec**, 1dc in last dc ... 11 sts.
Work 1 row.
20th row – 1ch, 1dc in first dc, **Dec**, 1dc in each of next 5 sts, **Dec**, 1dc in last dc ... 9 sts.
21st row – Sl st in each of first 2 sts, 1dc in next st, 1htr in next st, 1tr in next st, 1htr in next st, 1dc in next st, sl st in each of last 2 sts.
Fasten off.

To Make Up

Sew inner ears to inside of outer ears with lower ends together, then sew securely to top of head. Stuff arms and legs and sew securely in position as pictured. Using **C2** and satin stitch, embroider nose. Using Black and satin stitch, embroider eyes. Attach tail.
