BEGINNER SCARF

Beginner Knitting

MEASUREMENTS

Width (approx) 25cm
Length (approx) 180cm

PANDA RENEW MAX 100g balls

Quantity (8503 Blue Lake) 7

Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results. Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters. Ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- 1 pair 10mm (UK 000) knitting needles.
- 1 piece of cardboard 28cm wide for tassels.
- wool needle for finishing.

TENSION

Correct tension is not essential for this scarf.

NOTE – Scarf is worked on larger needles than usually recommended for this yarn.

SCARF

Using 10mm needles, cast on 23 sts loosely.

1st row – Knit.

Repeat last row for garter stitch.

Work in garter stitch until Scarf measures 180cm from beginning.

Cast off loosely.

TO MAKE UP

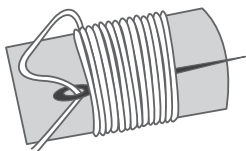
Sew in ends along rows, not along the edge.

TASSELS –

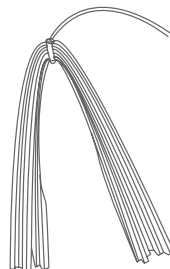
Wrap yarn around piece of cardboard 5 times and cut along one edge. Make a tassel and attach to first stitch on one end. Repeat evenly along both ends of Scarf. Trim neatly.

TASSELS

1. Wind yarn (closely together) around cardboard to desired tassel thickness. Cut yarn approx 20cm from tassel and thread this through a wool needle. Slip needle under all strands along one side of cardboard and tie a knot securely around the strands. (This yarn can be used to attach the tassel to your item when tassel is complete).



2. Cut the strands on the opposite side of the cardboard to the tie made in step 1.



3. Cut a separate piece of yarn approx 30cm long. Wrap tightly below top knot to secure strands. Hold firmly and thread end into wool needle. Stitch end to centre of tassel. Trim tassel ends evenly.
