

# Country Throw

Easy Knitting

## MEASUREMENTS

Throw measures (approx)	cm	100 x 130
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## MATERIALS

### CLECKHEATON COUNTRY 8 PLY 50g balls

5 balls of Pink (2267)

2 balls each of Auburn (2362), Lolly Pink (1977), Vintage (2332), Green (2346) and Maroon (0018)

1 ball each of Splice (2314), Bone (2334), Harvest Gold (2361), Sandstone (2343), Citron (2315), Cameo (2336), Garnet (2323), Barberry (2345), Soft Green (1962), Eco Green (2194), Dijon (2313), Mallard (2308), Soft Blue (1935), Periwinkle (2344), Royal Blue (0288), Navy (0048), Dark Violet (2181), Deep Red (1872) and Brown (2259)

### and CLECKHEATON COUNTRY NATURALS 8 PLY 50g balls

2 balls each of Denim (1840) and Ox Blood (1912)

1 ball each of Grey (1813), Teal (2004) and Bramble (2005)

Use only the yarns specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results. Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn of the same colour is from the same dye lot.

- 1 pair 4.5mm (UK 7) knitting needles or size needed to give correct tension.
- wool needle for sewing seams.

## TENSION

19.5 sts and 36 rows to 10cm over garter st, using 4.5mm needles. Check your tension carefully. If less sts to 10cm use smaller needles, if more sts use larger needles.



**SQUARE** (make 2 in each of Golds, Greens and Blues and 3 in each of Pinks and Reds ... 12 in all)

Using 4.5mm needles and Block 1 colour (see table), cast on 12 sts.

### Block 1 –

Work 23 rows garter st (knit every row – first row is wrong side).

Cast off loosely.

### Block 2 –

With right side of Block 1 facing and using Block 2 colour, knit up one st in each garter st ridge along left side edge ... 12 sts.

Work 23 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely.

### Block 3 –

With right side of Blocks facing, beg at top of Block 2 (cast-off edge) and using Block 3 colour, knit up 12 sts along left side edge of Block 2, then knit up 12 sts across cast-on sts of Block 1 ... 24 sts.

Work 23 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely.

### Block 4 –

With right side of Blocks facing, beg at top of Block 3 and using Block 4 colour, knit up 12 sts along left side edge of Block 3, then knit up 12 sts along side edge of Block 1 ... 24 sts.

Work 23 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely.

### Block 5 –

With right side of Blocks facing, beg at top of Block 4 and using Block 5 colour, knit up 12 sts along left side edge of Block 4, then knit up 12 sts across cast-off sts of Block 1, then knit up 12 sts along side edge of Block 2 ... 36 sts.

Work 23 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely.

### Block 6 –

With right side of Blocks facing, beg at top of Block 5 and using Block 6 colour, knit up 12 sts along left side edge of Block 5, then knit up 12 sts across cast-off sts of Block 2, then knit up 12 sts along side edge of Block 3 ... 36 sts.

Work 23 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely.

### Block 7 –

With right side of Blocks facing, beg at top of Block 6 and using Block 7 colour, knit up 12 sts along left side edge of Block 6, then knit up 24 sts across cast-off sts of Block 3, then knit up 12 sts along side edge of Block 4 ... 48 sts.

Work 23 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely.

## Block 8 –

With right side of Blocks facing, beg at top of Block 7 and using Block 8 colour, knit up 12 sts along left side edge of Block 7, then knit up 24 sts across cast-off sts of Block 4, then knit up 12 sts along side edge of Block 5 ... 48 sts.

Work 23 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely.

## Block 9 –

With right side of Blocks facing, beg at top of Block 8 and using Block 9 colour, knit up 12 sts along left side edge of Block 8, then knit up 36 sts across cast-off sts of Block 5, then knit up 12 sts along side edge of Block 6 ... 60 sts.

Work 23 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely, completing square.

## SIDE BORDERS (make 2)

**NOTE** – We recommend using mattress stitch to sew up your squares.

Join squares together following assembly diagram.

Using 4.5mm needles and Pink, cast on 10 sts.

Work in garter st until border is long enough to fit (slightly stretched) along side edges.

Cast off.

Sew Side Borders in position.

## UPPER AND LOWER BORDERS (make 2)

Using 4.5mm needles and Pink, cast on 10 sts.

Work in garter st until border is long enough to fit (slightly stretched) along upper and lower edges, including Borders.

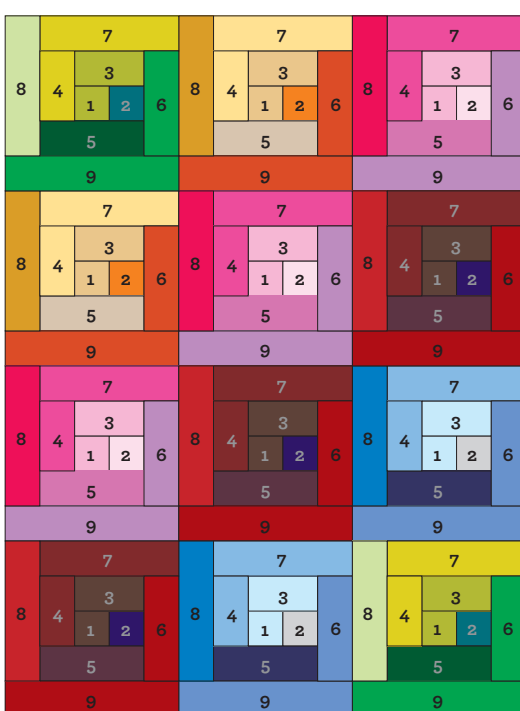
Cast off.

## TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Sew Upper and Lower Borders in position. Sew in ends.

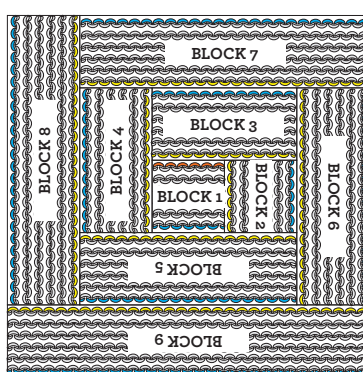

## ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM

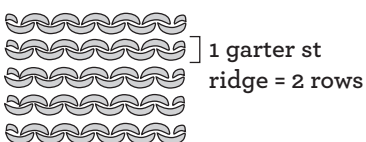
