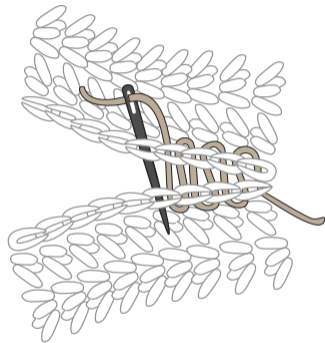
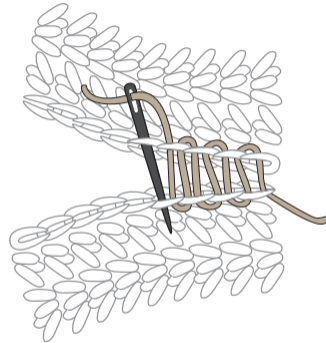


RUNNING STITCH SEAM

A running stitch seam can be used to produce a raised, decorative seam or a hidden invisible seam – it depends on which side of the work is uppermost when sewing. For a raised, decorative seam – With right side facing, work under one or two loops of the last row of stitches. For a hidden seam – With wrong side facing, work under both loops of the last row of stitches.
