

DOUBLE CROCHET CUSHION

■ ■ Easy Crochet

MEASUREMENTS

Finished size (approx) cm 40 x 40

PATONS REGAL 4 PLY COTTON 50g balls

Warm Colourway

1st Colour (C1 – 2729 Hot Pink)	2
2nd Colour (C2 – 2730 Light Pink)	1
3rd Colour (C3 – 030 White)	1
4th Colour (C4 – 3534 Scarlet)	1
5th Colour (C5 – 2731 Orange)	1
6th Colour (C6 – 2728 Natural)	2

Cool Colourway

1st Colour (C1 – 2799 Aqua)	2
2nd Colour (C2 – 7346 Chocolate)	1
3rd Colour (C3 – 030 White)	1
4th Colour (C4 – 5567 Khaki)	1
5th Colour (C5 – 5757 Emerald)	1
6th Colour (C6 – 2727 Grey)	2

Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results.

Quantities are approximate as they can vary between crochet workers. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

HOOK AND EXTRAS

- 3.00mm (UK 11) crochet hook or size needed to give correct tension.
- 45cm x 45cm cushion insert.
- tapestry needle for sewing seams.

TENSION

22dc and 28 rows to 10cm over dc fabric, using 3.00mm hook.

To work a tension square, using 3.00mm hook, make 35ch.

Work 42 rows dc fabric. Fasten off.

Check your tension carefully.

If less sts to 10cm use a smaller hook, if more sts use a larger hook.

With correct yarn and tension, your cushion will look like our photograph.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

Dec = draw up a lp in each of next 2 sts, yoh and draw through all 3 lps on hook.

SQUARE 1 (make 2)

Using 3.00mm hook and C5, make 3ch.

1st row – Miss 1ch, 1dc in each of next 2ch ... 2dc.

2nd row – 1ch, 2dc in each of next 2dc ... 4dc.

3rd row – 1ch, 2dc in first dc, 1dc in each dc to last dc, 2dc in last dc ... 6dc.

4th row – As 3rd row ... 8dc.

5th row – 1ch, 1dc in each st to end.

Rep 3rd row 3 times ... 14dc.

Rep last 4 rows twice ... 26dc.



NOTE – When changing colour, use new colour to work final lp of last st in old colour.

Change to C2.

Rep last 4 rows until there are 44dc. **

Beg Dec –

***** NOTE** – When changing to new colour in centre of row, leave old colour attached to be used again in second half of foll row.

Next row – Using C3, 1ch, 1dc in each of next 22dc, using C4, 1dc in each st to end.

Next row – Using C4, 1ch, Dec, 1dc in each of next 20dc, using C3, 1dc in each dc to last 2dc, Dec ... 42 sts.

Next row – Using C3, 1ch, Dec, 1dc in each of next 19dc, using C4, 1dc in each dc to last 2 sts, Dec ... 40 sts.

Next row – Using C4, 1ch, Dec, 1dc in each of next 18dc, using C3, 1dc in each dc to last 2 sts, Dec ... 38 sts.

Next row – Using C3, 1ch, 1dc in each of next 19 sts, using C4, 1dc in each st to end.

Keeping colour change correct, dec (as before) at each end of next 3 rows.

Work 1 row.

Rep last 4 rows until 2 sts rem.

Fasten off.

SQUARE 2 (make 2)

Work as for Square 1 to ** using C4 in place of C5 and

C2 in same position.

Beg Dec –

Complete as for Square 1 from *** to end, reversing C3 and C4.

SQUARE 3 (make 2)

Work as for Square 1 to ** using **C3** in place of **C5** and **C1** in place of **C2**.

Beg Dec -

Complete as for Square 1 from *** to end, using **C3** and **C4** in same position.

SQUARE 4 (make 2)

Work as for Square 1 to ** using **C1** in place of **C5** and **C5** in place of **C2**.

Beg Dec -

Complete as for Square 1 from *** to end, reversing **C3** and **C4**.

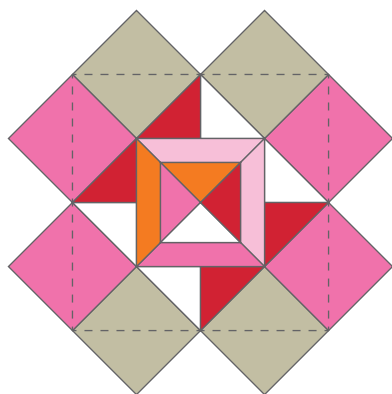
PLAIN SQUARE (make 4 each in C1 and C6)

Work as for Square 1, using same colour throughout.

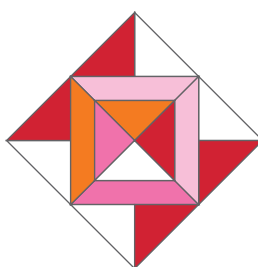
TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Using half mattress stitch seam and following assembly diagram, sew squares together. Fold **C1** and **C6** squares along dotted lines, then sew back in position, adding cushion insert before completing final seam.

CUSHION BACK

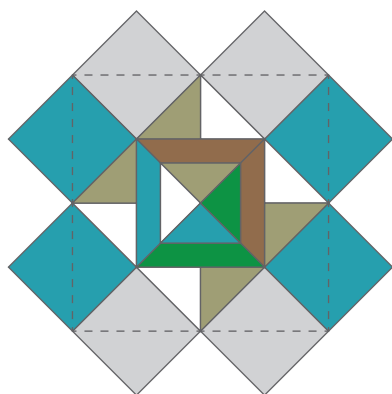

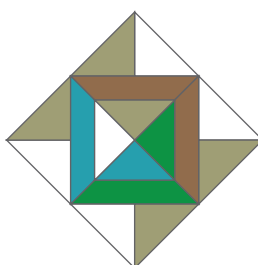
