

FISHERMAN'S RIB COWL

MEASUREMENTS

Width	cm	20
Circumference	cm	65

MATERIALS

CLECKHEATON WOOL MOHAIR 12 PLY 50g balls

Quantity (colour 0002) 3

Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results.

Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

- 1 pair 5.50mm (UK 5) knitting needles or size needed to give correct tension.
- wool needle for sewing seam and sewing in ends.

TENSION

This handknit has been designed at a tension of 16 sts and 28 rows to 10cm over fisherman's rib, using 5.50mm needles.

Check your tension carefully.

If less sts to 10cm use smaller needles, if more sts use bigger needles.

Note – To keep edges neat when starting a new ball of yarn, join 3 sts in from the edge. Ends can be sewn in along vertical rib lines instead of along edge of Cowl.

 Intermediate Knitting

COWL

Using 5.50mm needles, cast on 33 sts.

Foundation row (right side) – Slip 1, * P1, K1, repeat from * to end.

Begin Fisherman's Rib –

1st row (wrong side) – Slip 1, knit to end.

2nd row – Slip 1, * P1, **K1B**, repeat from * to last 2 sts, P1, K1.

Last 2 rows form pattern.

Continue in pattern until Cowl measures 65cm from beginning, working last row on **right** side.

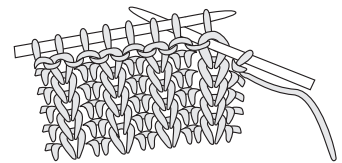
Cast off loosely purllways.

TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Join cast on and cast off edges to form Cowl. Sew in ends.

K1B – KNIT ONE BELOW

Insert right-hand needle through centre of stitch below next stitch on left-hand needle. Wind yarn round needle and knit as usual, at same time allowing stitch above to drop off needle.
