

JACKET WITH LONG COLLAR & CAP SLEEVES

MEASUREMENTS		XS	S	M	L	XL
To Fit Bust	cm	70	80	90	100	110
Actual Size	cm	78	88	98	108	118
Length	cm	59	60	61	62	63

MATERIALS

CLECKHEATON PERFECT DAY 8 PLY 50g balls

Quantity (colour 1001) 10 11 13 14 15

Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results.

Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters.

Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

- 1 pair 4.50mm knitting needles and a 4.50mm **circular** knitting needle or size needed to give correct tension.
- 1 stitch-holder.
- wool needle for sewing seams.

TENSION

21 sts and 28 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 4.50mm needles.

To work a tension square, using 4.50mm needles, cast on 31 sts. Work 42 rows stocking st. Cast off loosely.

Check your tension carefully.

If less sts to 10cm use smaller needles, if more sts use bigger needles.

NOTE – This garment has been worked on bigger needles and at a looser tension than usually recommended.

BACK AND FRONTS (worked in one piece to armholes)

Using 4.50mm **circular** needle, cast on **169** (189-209-229-249) sts.

NOTE – A circular needle has been used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work in rows not rounds.

Work 3 rows garter st (first row is wrong side).

Beg Lace Border –

1st row – Sl 1, K8, * yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K8, rep from * to end.

2nd and foll alt rows – Sl 1, purl to end.

3rd row – Sl 1, K6, * K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K5, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2.

5th row – Sl 1, K5, * K2tog, yfwd, K3, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K3, rep from * to last 3 sts, K3.

7th row – Sl 1, K4, * K2tog, yfwd, K5, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, rep from * to last 4 sts, K4.

9th row – Sl 1, K3, K2tog, yfwd, K7, * yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K7, rep from * to last 6 sts, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K4.

10th row – Sl 1, purl to end.

Rows 1 to 10 incl form patt.



 Intermediate

Cont in patt until work measures approx 20cm from beg, ending with a 10th patt row and inc 2 sts evenly across this row ... **171** (191-**211**-231-**251**) sts.

Working in stocking st for rem (slipping first st of every row as before), cont until work measures 39cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

Divide for Armholes and Shape Front Slope –

1st row – K2tog, **K38** (42-**45**-49-**52**), cast off next **8** (10-**14**-16-**19**) sts, **K75** (83-**89**-97-**105**) (including st rem on right-hand needle after cast off), cast off next **8** (10-**14**-16-**19**) sts, knit to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Cont on last **39** (43-**46**-50-**53**) sts for **Left Front**.

Dec one st at armhole edge in every row **2** (2-**2**-2-**4**) times, then in every foll alt row **3** (5-**6**-7-**7**) times, AT SAME TIME dec one st at front edge in every foll alt row **5** (9-**7**-9-**9**) times ... **29** (27-**31**-32-**33**) sts.

Dec one st at front edge only in every foll 3rd row until **14** (15-**17**-19-**21**) sts rem.

Work **0** (3-**5**-6-**13**) rows.

Shape Shoulder –

Cast off **5** (5-**6**-6-**7**) sts at beg of next row and foll alt row. Work 1 row.

Cast off rem **4** (5-**5**-7-**7**) sts.

With wrong side facing, join yarn to next group of sts, P2tog, **P71** (79-**85**-93-**101**), P2tog.

Cont on these **73** (81-**87**-95-**103**) sts for **Back**.

Dec one st at each end of next **1** (1-**1**-1-**3**) rows, then in every foll alt row until **65** (69-**73**-79-**83**) sts rem.

Work **41** (39-**41**-41-**43**) rows.

Shape Back Neck –

Next row – **K19** (20-**22**-24-**26**), **turn**.

Cont on these **19** (20-**22**-24-**26**) sts for right side of back neck.

Dec one st at neck edge in every row until **14** (15-**17**-19-**21**) sts rem.

Shape Shoulder –

Cast off **5** (5-6-6-7) sts at beg of next row and foll alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem **4** (5-5-7-7) sts.

Slip next **27** (29-29-31-31) sts onto stitch-holder and leave for collar.

With right side facing, join yarn to rem sts of Back and knit to end.

Cont on these **19** (20-22-24-26) sts for left side of back neck.

Dec one st at neck edge in every row until **14** (15-17-19-21) sts rem.

Work 1 row.

Shape Shoulder –

Cast off **5** (5-6-6-7) sts at beg of next row and foll alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem **4** (5-5-7-7) sts.

With wrong side of work facing, join yarn to rem sts, purl to last 2 sts, P2tog.

Cont on these **39** (43-46-50-53) sts for **Right Front**.

Dec one st at armhole edge in every row **2** (2-2-2-4) times,

then in every foll alt row **3** (5-6-7-7) times, AT SAME TIME

dec one st at front edge in every foll alt row **5** (9-7-9-9)

times ... **29** (27-31-32-33) sts.

Dec one st at front edge only in every foll 3rd row until

14 (15-17-19-21) sts rem.

Work **1** (4-6-7-14) rows.

Shape Shoulder –

Cast off **5** (5-6-6-7) sts at beg of next row and foll alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem **4** (5-5-7-7) sts.

CAP SLEEVES

Using 4.50mm needles, cast on **45** (49-57-63-71) sts.

Work 3 rows garter st (1st row is wrong side).

Working in stocking st for rem (beg with a knit row), dec

one st at each end of next row, then in every foll alt row

until **13** (17-29-37-49) sts rem, then in every row until

11 sts rem.

Cast off.

COLLAR

NOTE – We recommend using mattress stitch to sew up your jacket.

Join shoulder seams. With right side facing, using 4.50mm

circular needle and beg at right front slope shaping, knit

up **42** (46-46-50-50) sts evenly along right front slope to

shoulder seam, knit up 5 sts evenly along right side of

back neck, knit across sts from back stitch-holder, knit up

5 sts evenly along left back neck to shoulder seam, then

knit up **42** (46-46-50-50) sts evenly along left front slope

to beg of straight front edge ... **121** (131-131-141-141) sts.

Work in stocking st (beg with a **knit** row and slipping first

st of every row) until collar measures 20cm from beg,

ending with a purl row.

Beg Lace Border –

1st row – Sl 1, * K4, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K4, rep from * to end.

2nd and foll alt rows – Sl 1, purl to end.

3rd row – Sl 1, * K2, K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1,

pssso, K3, rep from * to end.

5th row – Sl 1, * K1, K2tog, yfwd, K3, yfwd, sl 1, K1,

pssso, K2, rep from * to end.

7th row – Sl 1, * K2tog, yfwd, K5, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso,

K1, rep from * to end.

9th row – K2tog, yfwd, K7, * yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, pssso,

yfwd, K7, rep from * to last 2 sts, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso.

10th row – Sl 1, purl to end.

Rows 1 to 10 incl form patt.

Cont in patt until Collar measures approx 40cm from beg,

ending with a 10th patt row.

Work 4 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely.

TO MAKE UP

Placing centre of sleeve to shoulder seam, sew in sleeves,

noting that sleeves will begin and end approx 3cm above

cast-off for armholes on Back and Fronts. Turn Collar to

right side.
