

GARTER STITCH SCARF

with optional fringe

Beginner

MEASUREMENTS

Width	cm	16
Length (approx, excluding fringe)	cm	140

MATERIALS

CLECKHEATON AURORA 100g balls

Quantity (854 Chiron) 3

Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results.

Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

- 1 pair 15mm knitting needles.
- wool needle for finishing.
- piece of cardboard for fringe (optional).

TENSION

Correct tension is not essential for this scarf.

SCARF

If making with fringe, cut 24 lengths of yarn each 30cm long and set aside.

Using 15mm needles, cast on 10 sts.

Work in garter st (knit every row) until approx 60cm of 3rd ball remains.

Cast off loosely.

TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Sew in ends.

Optional Fringe –

With 2 lengths of fringe together, fold in half and push the fold through one end of cast-on edge. Draw ends through and pull to tighten. Repeat at each corner of scarf, then space remaining fringes evenly between. Trim neatly.
