

GARTER STITCH SCARF

MEASUREMENTS

Width (approx)	cm	21
Length (approx, excluding fringe)	cm	180

MATERIALS

CLECKHEATON COUNTRY WIDE 50g balls

1st Colour (**C1** – 0013 Emerald) 6

2nd Colour (**C2** – 0003 Charcoal) 5

Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results.

Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters.

Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

- 1 pair 7.00mm (UK 2) knitting needles.
- wool needle for sewing in ends.
- piece of cardboard 23cm wide and crochet hook for fringe.

TENSION

Correct tension is not essential for this Scarf.

SCARF

Using 7.00mm needles and **C1**, cast on 28 stitches **loosely**.

Work 2 rows garter stitch (every row knit).

Beg Stripe Patt –

Note – Do not break off colours when not in use, but carry loosely up side edge until required again.

Using **C2**, knit 2 rows.

Using **C1**, knit 2 rows.

Last 4 rows form stripe pattern.

Cont in stripe pattern until Scarf measures 180cm from beginning or until near end of last **C2** ball, ending with a complete stripe.

Cast off **loosely** in same colour.



TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Sew in ends. To make fringe, wind **C1** around a piece of cardboard 23cm wide and cut along one edge. Using 5 lengths for each fringe, fold in half then use crochet hook to draw loop through a stitch at end of Scarf. Draw ends through loop and pull to tighten. Repeat evenly along both ends of Scarf. Trim evenly.
