Rib Beanie

PATONS CLASSIC TOTEM 8 PLY

To fit average size head 3 balls **TOTEM**
50g balls

NEEDLES—

Milwards Disc or Patons Beehive Knitting Needles—

Loose Knitters 1 set of four No. 9

Average Knitters 1 set of four No. 8

Tight Knitters 1 set of four No. 7

Needle size in instructions is that for Average Knitters.

Needle size depends upon your tension, which should be $11\frac{1}{2}$ stitches to 2 inches in width, measured over plain smooth fabric. Check tension carefully.

ABBREVIATIONS: See website.

Using set of four No. 8 Needles, cast on 126 stitches. (42-42-42)

1st round.—* K.1, P.1, rep. from * to end of round. Rep. 1st round until work measures $7\frac{1}{2}$ ins. from commencement.

Next round.—* Slip 1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., P.1, K.1, P.1, rep. from * to end of round. (84 sts.)

Work 2 rounds.

Next round.—* K.1, P.3 tog., rep. from * to end of round. (42 sts.)

Work 2 rounds.

Next round.—* slip 1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., P.1, rep. from * to last 2 sts., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o. (21 sts.)

Break off yarn, thread end through remaining sts., draw up and fasten off securely.

Make a loose Pom-Pon and attach to top (see website).
