STYLE A – Striped Sweater (as pictured)

Main Colour (M – 8736)	5	5	6	6	7
1st Contrast (C1 – 8735)	2	2	3	3	4
2nd Contrast (C2 – 8728)	2	2	3	3	4

STYLE B – Single Colour Sweater

Quantity	7	8	9	10	11
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Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results. Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- 1 pair 7.00mm (UK 2) knitting needles and a **set** of 4.00mm (UK 8) **double-pointed** knitting needles or size needed to give correct tension.
- one 6.00mm **double-pointed** knitting needle (as cable needle).
- wool needle and plain yarn for sewing seams.

TENSION

15 sts and 23 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 7.00mm needles. Check your tension carefully. If less sts to 10cm use smaller needles, if more sts use larger needles.

NOTE – This sweater is worked on larger needles and at a looser tension than usually recommended for this yarn.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

C24B = Slip next 12 sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K12, then K12 from cable needle.

C24F = Slip next 12 sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work, K12, then K12 from cable needle.

STYLES A & B (STYLE B USE SINGLE COLOUR THROUGHOUT) BACK

Using 7.00mm needles and **M**, cast on **76** (84-92-100-108) sts. Work 5 rows garter st (1st row is wrong side), inc 6 sts evenly across last row ... **82** (90-98-106-114) sts.

Next row (right side) – Purl.

Next row – Knit.

Last 2 rows form purl fabric.

Cont in purl fabric, work 38 rows **M**, 24 rows **C1**, 10 rows **M** and 24 rows **C2**. Working in **M** for rem, work **26** (28-30-32-36) rows.



Shape Back Neck and Shoulders –

Next row – Cast off **6** (7-8-8-9) sts, **P21** (23-25-28-31) *incl st rem on right-hand needle after casting off*, cast off next **28** (30-32-34-34) sts, purl to end.

Cont on these **27** (30-33-36-40) sts for left side of neck.

Cast off **6** (7-8-8-9) sts at beg of next row, then in foll alt rows twice, AT SAME TIME dec one st at neck edge in next 3 rows ... **6** (6-6-9-10) sts. Work 1 row. Cast off rem sts.

With wrong side facing, join yarn to rem **21** (23-25-28-31) sts for right side of neck.

Cast off **6** (7-8-8-9) sts at beg of foll alt rows twice, AT SAME TIME dec one st at neck edge in next 3 rows ... **6** (6-6-9-10) sts.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem sts.

FRONT

Using 7.00mm needles and **M**, cast on **90** (96-104-112-120) sts. Work 5 rows garter st (1st row is wrong side), inc 6 sts evenly across last row ... **96** (102-110-118-126) sts.

Next row – **P32** (35-39-43-47), K15, inc in each of next 2 sts, K15, purl to end ... **98** (104-112-120-128) sts.

Next row – **K32** (35-39-43-47), P34, knit to end.

Next row – **P32** (35-39-43-47), K16, inc in each of next 2 sts, K16, purl to end ... **100** (106-114-122-130) sts.

Next row – **K32** (35-39-43-47), P36, knit to end.

Next row – **P32** (35-39-43-47), K17, inc in each of next 2 sts, K17, purl to end ... **102** (108-116-124-132) sts.

Cont inc 2 sts (as before) in centre of every foll alt row until there are **112** (118-126-134-142) sts, working last row on wrong side.

Beg Cable Panel –

1st row – P32 (35-39-43-47), C24B, C24F, P32 (35-39-43-47).

2nd row – K32 (35-39-43-47), P48, K32 (35-39-43-47).

3rd row – P32 (35-39-43-47), K48, P32 (35-39-43-47).

4th row – As 2nd row.

Rep 3rd and 4th rows 9 times.

Last 22 rows form cable patt for Front.

Keeping patt correct, work a further 2 rows **M**, then 24 rows **C1**, 10 rows **M** and 24 rows **C2**.

Working in **M** for rem, work **3** (3-3-3-5) rows.

Next row (wrong side) – K32 (35-39-43-47), (P1, P2tog) 8 times, (P2tog, P1) 8 times, K32 (35-39-43-47) ... **96** (102-110-118-126) sts.

Shape Neck –

Next row – P32 (35-39-43-47), cast off next 32 sts, purl to end.

Cont on these **32** (35-39-43-47) sts for right side of neck.

Dec one st at neck edge in every foll alt row **6** (5-6-7-6) times, then in every foll 4th row **2** (3-3-3-4) times ... **24** (27-30-33-37) sts.

Work 2 rows.

Shape Shoulder –

Cast off **6** (7-8-8-9) sts at beg of next row, then in every foll alt row twice.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem **6** (6-6-9-10) sts.

With wrong side facing, join yarn to rem **32** (35-39-43-47) sts for left side of neck.

Complete as for other side of neck, working 1 row less before shoulder shaping.

SLEEVES

Using 7.00mm needles and **C1**, cast on **28** (30-32-32-34) sts.

Work 5 rows garter st (1st row is wrong side), inc 2 sts evenly across last row ... **30** (32-34-34-36) sts.

Beg Stripe Patt –

Working in purl fabric (as before) beg shaping **and** stripe patt as folls – work 24 rows **C1**, 10 rows **M**, 24 rows **C2**, then work in **M** for rem, AT SAME TIME inc one st at each end of 5th row once, then in every foll **6th** (6th-4th-4th-4th) row until there are **52** (54-48-56-70) sts, then in every foll **8th** (8th-6th-6th-6th) row until there are **54** (56-62-66-72) sts.

Cont until Sleeve measures 39cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

Shape Top –

Cast off **10** (10-11-12-13) sts **loosely** at beg of next 4 rows.

Cast off rem **14** (16-18-18-20) sts **loosely**.

NECKBAND

NOTE – We recommend using mattress stitch to sew up your sweater.

Join shoulder seams. With right side facing, using **set** of 4.00mm **double-pointed** needles and **M**, knit up **16** (16-18-18-20) sts evenly along left side of front neck, fold right side of cable panel to resemble knitted cable then working through 3 thicknesses knit up 4 sts, knit up one st in centre of cable, fold left side of cable panel to resemble left side of knitted cable then working through 3 thicknesses knit up 4 sts, knit up **16** (16-18-18-20) sts evenly along right side of front neck to shoulder, knit up 5 sts evenly along right side of back neck, knit up **16** (16-17-18-18) sts evenly across back cast off, then knit up 5 sts evenly along left side of back neck ... **67** (67-72-73-77) sts.

Purl 9 rounds.


Cast off **very loosely**.

TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Measure **17** (18-19-20-21) cm down from shoulder seam on Back and Front and tie a coloured thread at side edges to mark armholes. Placing centre of sleeve to shoulder seam, sew in sleeves evenly between coloured threads. Join side and sleeve seams.

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
