PONCHO

PATONS RAINBOW 8 PLY 200g balls

Quantity (both colour 245) 1 1 2 2 2

Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results.

Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

COLOUR NOTE – Due to Rainbow's unique manufacturing process, each of the colours of Rainbow have a random, ever changing appearance. This means balls in the same dyelot may not look the same. If more than 1 ball is required for a project, select balls that look similar on the outer surface if possible. Work from one ball only when using Rainbow or the unique rainbow appearance will disappear. Be aware that the colour effect pictured may vary.

NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- one each 40cm and 80cm long 4.00mm (UK 8) **circular** knitting needles and a 40cm long 5.00mm (UK 6) **circular** knitting needle for Poncho or size needed to give correct tension.
- 1 pair each 3.25mm (UK 10) and 4.00mm (UK 8) knitting needles for Gauntlets or size needed to give correct tension.
- wool needle for finishing.

TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 4.00mm needles.

Check your tension carefully.

If less sts to 10cm use smaller needles, if more sts use bigger needles.

PONCHO

Using longer 4.00mm **circular** needle, cast on **240** (264-**288**-300-**324**) sts.

Join to work in rounds, taking care not to twist cast on edge.



Beg Patt –

1st round – * K7, P5, rep from * to end.

Last round forms rib patt.

Work a further 8 rounds rib.

NOTE – Change to shorter needle when there are too few sts to fit around longer needle.

10th round – * K5, K2tog, P5, rep from * to end ... **220** (242-**264**-275-**297**) sts.

11th round – * K6, P5, rep from * to end.

Rep last round **8** (8-**8**-8-**10**) times.

Next round – * K6, P3, P2tog, rep from * to end ... **200** (220-**240**-250-**270**) sts.

Next round – * K6, P4, rep from * to end.

Rep last round **6** (8-**8**-8-**8**) times.

Next round – * K4, K2tog, P4, rep from * to end ... **180** (198-**216**-225-**243**) sts.

Next round – * K5, P4, rep from * to end.

Rep last round **6** (8-**8**-8-**8**) times.

Next round – * K5, P2, P2tog, rep from * to end ... **160** (176-**192**-200-**216**) sts.

Next round – * K5, P3, rep from * to end.

Rep last round **6** (6-**8**-8-**8**) times.

Next round – * K3, K2tog, P3, rep from * to end ... **140** (154-**168**-175-**189**) sts.

Next round – * K4, P3, rep from * to end.

Rep last round **6** (6-**6**-8-**8**) times.

Next round – * K4, P1, P2tog, rep from * to end ... **120** (132-**144**-150-**162**) sts.

Next round – * K4, P2, rep from * to end.

Rep last round **6** (6-6-8-8) times.

Next round – * K2, K2tog, P2, rep from * to end ... **100** (110-120-125-135) sts.

Beg Collar –

1st round – * K3, P2, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st round until collar measures 10cm from beg.

Change to 5.00mm **circular** needle and rep 1st round until collar measures 20cm from beg.

Cast off **loosely** in rib.

TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Fold collar to right side.

GAUNTLETS (make 2 alike)

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on **38** (46) sts loosely.

1st row – K2, * P2, K2, rep from * to end.

2nd row – P2, * K2, P2, rep from * to end.

Last 2 rows form rib.

Rep last 2 rows twice, 6 rows rib in all.

Change to 4.00mm needles.

Work in stocking st until work measures **22** (25) cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

Change to 3.25mm needles.

Work 6 rows rib (as before).

Cast off **loosely** in rib.

TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Join side edges together, leaving **3** (4) cm gap for thumb hole, 4cm from cast on edge.

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
