

# GARTER STITCH COWL

■ Beginner

## MEASUREMENTS

Width (approx)	cm	20
Circumference (approx)	cm	120

## PATONS GIGANTE 100g BALLS

Quantity (blue) 2

Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results.

Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

## NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- 1 pair 15mm knitting needles.
- wool needle for sewing seam.

## TENSION

Correct tension is not essential for this cowl.

## COWL

Using 15mm needles, cast on 13 stitches very loosely.

**NOTE** – To keep edges neat, when starting new balls of yarn, join 3 stitches in from edge, so that ends can be woven through work and not along the edge.

**1st row** – Knit.

Repeat last row for garter stitch.

Continue in garter stitch until cowl measures approx 120cm in length, or near end of 2nd ball, leaving approx 2m for finishing.

Cast off very loosely.

## TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Using a flat seam join cast-on and cast-off edges together. Sew in ends.
