

HAT AND SCARF SET



Intermediate Knitting



MEASUREMENTS

	YEARS	2-4	6-8
Hat To Fit Head	cm	52	54
Scarf Measures	cm	13 x 116	

SHEPHERD COLOUR 4 ME 8 PLY 50G BALLS

Main Colour (M – 5026 Garnet)	3	3
Contrast Colour (C – 4952 Lime)	2	2

Be sure to check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot. Use only the yarn specified for these garments. Other yarns may give unsatisfactory results. Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters.

NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- 1 pair 4.00mm (UK 8) knitting needles for Scarf, and a **set** each of 3.25mm (UK 10) and 4.00mm **double-pointed** knitting needles for Hat or size needed to give correct tension.
- wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION

This hat and scarf set has been designed at a tension of 22 sts and 30 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 4.00mm needles. To work a tension square, using 4.00mm needles, cast on 33 sts. Work 44 rows stocking st. Cast off loosely. Check your tension carefully. If less sts to 10cm use smaller needles, if more sts use larger needles.

HAT

Using **set** of 3.25mm **double-pointed** needles and **C**, cast on **104** (108) sts and divide as evenly as possible onto 3 needles. Join to work in rounds, taking care not to twist cast-on edge. Work 10 rounds stocking st (every round knit). Change to **set** of 4.00mm **double-pointed** needles. Using **M**, purl 1 round (to create two colour ridge). Working in **M** and stocking st for rem, cont until hat measures **11** (13) cm from beg, dec **0** (4) sts evenly in last round ... 104 sts.

SHAPE CROWN -

1st round – * K11, K2tog, rep from * to end ... 96 sts.

2nd and foll alt rounds – Knit.

3rd round – * K10, K2tog, rep from * to end ... 88 sts.

5th round – * K9, K2tog, rep from * to end ... 80 sts.

7th round – * K8, K2tog, rep from * to end ... 72 sts.

Cont dec in this manner, working one st less between each dec in every foll alt round until 16 sts rem.

Next round – * K2tog, rep from * to end ... 8 sts.

Break off yarn, thread end through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

SCARF

Using 4.00mm needles and **C**, cast on 33 sts.

BEG PATT -

1st row – K2, P1, K1, P1, knit to last 5 sts, P1, K1, P1, K2.

2nd row – (K1, P1) twice, K1, purl to last 5 sts, K1, (P1, K1) twice.

Last 2 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until Scarf measures 18cm from beg, ending with a 1st patt row.

Change to **M**.

Next row – As 1st row (to create two colour ridge).

Work 40cm in patt, beg and ending with a 1st patt row.

Change to **C**.

Next row – As 1st row (to create two colour ridge).

Work 40cm in patt, beg and ending with a 1st patt row.

Change to **M**.

Next row – As 1st row (to create two colour ridge).

Work 18cm in patt, beg and ending with a 1st patt row.

Cast off in patt.

TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Sew in ends.
