

# MOTIF CUSHION

## MEASUREMENTS

Cushion measures (approx) 40cm x 40cm

## MATERIALS

CLECKHEATON ARTISAN 12 PLY 50g balls

Quantity (colour 14 Amazonia) 6

Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results.

Quantities are approximate as they can vary between crochet workers.

Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

- 4.50mm (UK 7) crochet hook.
- 45cm cushion insert.
- wool needle for sewing in ends.

## TENSION

Correct tension is not essential for this cushion.

**Note** – This cushion is worked on a smaller hook than usually recommended for this yarn.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**beg** = beginning; **ch** = chain; **cont** = continue;  
**dc** = double crochet; **htr** = half treble; **inc** = increases;  
**rem** = remainder; **rep** = repeat; **sp** = space;  
**sl st** = slip stitch; **st, sts** = stitch, stitches; **tr** = treble.

## MOTIF (make 2)

Using 4.50mm hook, make 4ch and join with a sl st to first ch to make a ring.

**Note** – As rounds are not completed with a sl st but worked in a spiral shape, mark end of rounds with a contrasting thread or safety pin.

**1st round** – 3ch, 11tr in ring, do not join.

**2nd round** – 2dc in 3rd ch at beg of last round, 2htr in next tr, (2tr in next tr) 10 times ... 24 sts.

**3rd round** – \* 2tr in next st, 1tr in next st, rep from \* to end ... 36tr.

**4th round** – \* 2tr in next tr, 1tr in each of next 2tr, rep from \* to end ... 48tr.

**5th round** – \* 2tr in next tr, 1tr in each of next 3tr, rep from \* to end ... 60tr.

**6th round** – \* 2tr in next tr, 1tr in each of next 4tr, rep from \* to end ... 72tr.

Cont inc 12tr every round in this manner (working 1tr more between inc each round) until there are 132tr, 11 rounds in all.



 Easy Crochet

**12th round** – \* 1htr in each of next 2tr, 1dc in each of next 24tr, 1htr in each of next 2tr, miss 2tr, (1dtr, 2tr, 2ch, 2tr, 1dtr) in next tr (corner made), miss 2tr, rep from \* 3 times, sl st in first htr ... 4 corners.

**Note** – Rem of Motif is worked in rounds, not in a spiral.

**13th round** – 3ch, 1tr in next htr, \* 1htr in each of next 3dc, 1dc in each of next 18dc, 1htr in each of next 3dc, 1tr in each st to corner, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in 2ch sp at corner, 1tr in each of next 5 sts, rep from \* ending last rep 1tr in each of last 3 sts, sl st in 3rd ch at beg.

**14th round** – 3ch, 1tr in each of next 4 sts, \* 1htr in each of next 3dc, 1dc in each of next 12dc, 1htr in each of next 3dc, 1tr in each st to corner, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in 2ch sp, 1tr in each of next 10 sts, rep from \* ending last rep 1tr in each of last 5 sts, sl st in 3rd ch at beg.

**15th round** – 3ch, 1tr in each of next 7 sts, \* 1htr in each of next 3dc, 1dc in each of next 6dc, 1htr in each of next 3dc, 1tr in each st to corner, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in 2ch sp, 1tr in each of next 15 sts, rep from \* ending last rep 1tr in each of last 7 sts, sl st in 3rd ch at beg.

**16th round** – 3ch, \* 1tr in each st to corner, 5tr in 2ch sp, rep from \* 3 times, 1tr in each st to end, sl st in 3rd ch at beg. Fasten off.

## TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. With wrong sides together, using 4.50mm hook and working through both thicknesses, work a round of dc evenly around all edges, working 3dc in each corner and adding cushion insert before joining last edge, sl st in first dc. Fasten off.
